

City of Grand Island Nebraska Marks 25 Years Using Mainsaver Software

Grand Island, NE – January 29, 2018: The Utilities Division keeps the City of Grand Island Nebraska supplied with water and electricity. This group of 150 engineers, technicians, administrators and support staff covers this 30 square mile city with a population over 50,000. The use of Mainsaver started in 1992 with the Power Production Division. Over the years, Mainsaver was introduced to all of the Utility Departments as shown below.

Modules include Maintenance, Inventory, Purchasing, Preventive Maintenance, Invoice Matching and Timekeeping. Users can access Mainsaver through a workstation client, a web interface for entering work requests and the new Mainsaver Connect Mobility Module for managing work on smart devices. An interface between Mainsaver and various other systems exchanges data in order to make work processes more efficient. In one interface, all electrical and water distribution assets are synchronized between Mainsaver and the City's GIS system.
